INSULATION (Electrically Heated Living Areas Only)

- Ceiling Insulation
- Floor Insulation
- Wall Insulation

HEATING, COOLING, AND AIR SEALING

- Air Source (Standard) Heat Pumps
- Ductless Heat Pumps
- PTCS Heat Pump Commissioning & Duct Sealing

WINDOWS/DOORS

- Upgraded from existing single pane, single pane with storms, or dual pane with metal frames with NFRC Rating of U.30 or lower (weighted average)
- Upgraded Patio/French Doors with NFRC Rating of U.35 or lower
- Insulated exterior doors (energy star w/threshold replacing non insulated existing door)

OTHER MEASURES

- Upgrades not on the utility's rebate list are decided on case by case basis at utility's discretion.

QUALIFICATIONS

The rebate program is available for electrically heated homes located in utility's service area that qualify under each of the following guidelines:

- Structure where measure is installed and saving electric energy is within the utility's service area.
- The utility confirms the conservation measure is an eligible electric energy efficiency upgrade.
- Energy efficiency measure does not result in a conversion of energy or fuel type.

COMPLETE REBATE APPLICATION/PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT (Step 1)

To start the rebate application process, read the Residential Rebate Program informational packet. Using the attached Authorized Contractor list on page 5, call and arrange to get proposal(s). We recommend that you get more than one proposal.

OBTAIN PROPOSALS (Step 2)

You and your selected Authorized Contractor will complete the application forms together, and you will leave the forms with your contractor who will submit them to the utility when the installation of the project is complete. **Rebates exceeding \$10,000 will require pre-approval from the utility.**

INSTALLATION AND INSPECTION (Step 3)

1. The Authorized Contractor will complete the installation, notify the utility that the work has been completed, and submit the rebate application form and all program-required paperwork.
2. After the utility has received the paperwork from the contractor, we will contact you to coordinate an inspection of the project. You may request a copy of the approved inspection checklist from the inspector.
4. **The utility cannot release the rebate money until the conservation measure has passed inspection and all program requirements have been met. It is the contractor and homeowner's responsibility to ensure all information is accurate and meets program requirements to ensure funds will be released.**
5. After the conservation measures have passed inspection, a disbursement check will be released to the Authorized Contractor to reduce from your payment to the contractor. The utility will not credit your utility account or send you a check.

Only Authorized Contractors from our list may install measures under the utility's Residential Rebate Program, and will know program requirements. All work must pass the utility's inspection before rebate funds may be disbursed.
